"**Section 4.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any unappropriated funds in the budget reserve account on June 30, 2022 in excess of one hundred thirteen million one hundred eighty-five thousand dollars (\$113,185,000.00) and less than four hundred thirty-three million one hundred eighty-five thousand dollars (\$433,185,000.00) shall be transferred to the legislative stabilization reserve account. Any unappropriated funds in the budget reserve account on June 30, 2022 equal to or in excess of four hundred thirty-three million one hundred eighty-five thousand dollars (\$433,185,000.00) shall be transferred to the Wyoming's tomorrow scholarship endowment fund. Once the amount transferred to the Wyoming's tomorrow scholarship endowment fund reaches fifty million dollars (\$50,000,000.00), any unappropriated funds in the budget reserve account on June 30, 2022 equal to or in excess of four hundred eighty-three million one hundred eighty-five thousand dollars (\$483,185,000.00) shall be transferred to the legislative stabilization reserve account.".
