(e) Funds subject to subsection (d) of this section shall not be distributed until after June 1, 2022 and shall only be expended for community enhancement or economic development capital projects, including projects constructed by special districts. To be eligible for the grants, the board of

county commissioners and the governing bodies of the cities and towns within that county that comprise at least seventy percent (70%) of the incorporated population shall:

(i) Certify to the state loan and investment board that they have reached agreement on the projects for which the funds will be used; and

(ii) Certify a local match of at least one dollar (\$1.00) for every one dollar (\$1.00) in general fund funding under subsection (d) of this section.".

(i) In lieu of five percent (5%) of the amount available under paragraph (a)(i) of section 1 for direct distributions to cities and towns using the revenue challenged formula as provided in paragraph (b)(ii) of section 1, ten percent (10%) of two-thirds (2/3) of eighty-nine percent (89%) of the fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000.00) appropriated under this section shall be distributed for direct distributions to cities and towns using the revenue challenged formula as provided in paragraph (b)(ii) of section 1 of this act;

(iii) In lieu of receiving an amount equal to three (3) times the difference between three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) and the actual value of one (1) mill within the county as provided in paragraph (c)(i) of section 1, each county with an assessed value for the prior tax year

corresponding to the most recently completed calendar year of less than three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) per mill shall first receive an amount equal to the difference between three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) and the actual value of one (1) mill within the county. From the remainder of the amount available for direct distribution to counties, each county shall receive amounts in accordance with a county supplemental funding formula as provided in subparagraphs (c)(i)(A) through (O) of section 1 of this act.

(iii) In lieu of receiving an amount equal to three (3) times the difference between three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) and the actual value of one (1) mill within the county as provided in paragraph (c)(i) of section 1, each county with an assessed value for the prior tax year corresponding to the most recently completed calendar year of less than three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) per mill shall first receive an amount equal to the difference between three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) and the actual value of one (1) mill within the county. From the remainder of the amount available for direct distribution to counties, each county shall receive amounts in accordance with a county supplemental funding formula as provided in subparagraphs (c)(i)(A) through (O) of section 1 of this act.
