AN ACT relating to state lands; authorizing the department of state parks and cultural resources to lease state lands for recreational purposes as specified; authorizing the department to sell permits that allow for the recreational use of leased state lands; providing for the disposition of funds generated from permit sales allowing for the recreational use of leased state lands; authorizing the department to lease or rent concessions on leased state lands; making conforming amendments; authorizing rulemaking; and providing for effective dates.

Page 1-line 2 After "resources" insert "and private parties".

Page 4-line 21 After "board." insert "Before entering into a lease agreement under this paragraph, the department shall notify any lessee of state lands that the board has leased to the lessee for agricultural purposes and that the department is seeking to lease for recreational purposes. The agricultural lessee shall have the right to match the lease terms proposed by the department and may notify the board that it wishes to match the lease terms and lease the same state lands for recreational purposes. Any agricultural lessee entering into a leasing agreement for state lands for recreational purposes may develop and manage those leased state lands and shall comply with any rules promulgated by the board.". DRISKILL

Page 5-line 2 After "board." insert "The department shall not enter into more than five (5) leasing agreements with the board for purposes specified in this paragraph. Not later than October 1 of each year, the department shall report to both the joint agriculture, state and public lands and water resources interim committee and the joint travel, recreation, wildlife and cultural resources interim committee on the leasing agreements the department has entered into under this paragraph, the department's management and development of the leased state lands for recreational purposes and any recommendations for continuing or discontinuing the authority granted in this paragraph. This paragraph is repealed effective June 30, 2026.". HICKS
