1	(d) The number of retail liquor licenses issued shall
2	be based on the following population formula:

4	(iv) Retail liquor licenses issued to commercial
5	service airports in incorporated cities or towns shall be
6	exempt from the number restrictions in paragraphs (i)
7	through (iii) of this subsection.

9	(f) Retail liquor licenses and malt beverage permits
10	may be granted by the county commissioners as the
11	appropriate licensing authority in a county outside of
12	incorporated cities and towns as follows:

14	(ii) No more than three (3) retail liquor
15	licenses issued for locations within five (5) miles of the
16	corporate limits of a city or town. Retail liquor licenses
17	issued to commercial service airports in a county shall be
18	exempt from this paragraph; and

20	(m) A commercial service airport holding a retail
21	liquor license may contract for or otherwise subcontract
22	any food and beverage services provided at the airport to
