Vehicle registration specialty license plate fee;

Assumptions:
It is assumed that 1,000 sets of specialty license plates would be sold before December 21, 2031, at a rate of 111 sets of specialty license plates per year.

Application forms shall include the option for the applicant to donate $\$ 1.00$ or more to promote awareness and education efforts for procurement of organ, eyes and tissue anatomical gifts. The potential donation revenue is indeterminable.
