1 AN ACT relating to counties, cities and towns; prohibiting 2 counties, cities and towns from enacting and enforcing 3 policies on the use of animals as specified; and providing for an effective date. 4 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 6 7 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 15-1-133 and 18-2-117 are created to 9 read: 10 11 15-1-133. Working animal protections. 12 (a) No city or town shall enact an ordinance or 13 14 policy that terminates, bans or unduly impedes a person

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1 from using a working animal in lawful commerce or animal 2 enterprise. 3 4 (b) This section supersedes any municipal ordinance or policy that conflicts with this section, including any 5 conflicting municipal ordinance in effect prior to July 1, 6 7 2022, but shall not supersede: 8 9 (i) Any municipal zoning ordinance enacted under 10 this title; 11 (ii) Any municipal ordinance or policy relating 12 to public health or public safety. 13 14 (c) This section shall not be interpreted to amend 15 16 any other Wyoming law that relates to animal care, public 17 health or public safety, including the provisions of W.S. 23-3-109. 18 19 20 (d) As used in this section, "working animal" means a 21 nonhuman animal used primarily for the purpose of performing a specific duty or function in commerce or 22 animal enterprise including human service, legal hunting, 23 2 HB0066

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agriculture, ranching, husbandry, transportation, 1 2 education, competition, tourism, entertainment or 3 exhibition. The term does not include rabbits, llamas, 4 cattle, swine, sheep, goats, poultry or any other animal that is used primarily for the production of food or fiber. 5 б 7 18-2-117. Working animal protections. 8 (a) No county shall enact any resolution or policy 9 that terminates, bans or unduly impedes a person from using 10 a working animal in lawful commerce or animal enterprise. 11 12 (b) This section supersedes any resolution or policy 13 that conflicts with this section, including any conflicting 14 county resolution in effect prior to July 1, 2022, but 15 16 shall not supersede: 17 18 (i) Any county zoning resolution enacted under 19 this title; 20 21 (ii) Any policy relating to public health or public safety. 22 23

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1 (c) This section shall not be interpreted to amend 2 any other Wyoming law that relates to animal care, public 3 health or public safety, including the provisions of W.S. 4 23-3-109.

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(d) As used in this section, "working animal" means a 6 nonhuman animal used primarily for the purpose of 7 8 performing a specific duty or function in commerce or 9 animal enterprise including human service, legal hunting, 10 agriculture, ranching, husbandry, transportation, education, competition, tourism, entertainment 11 or 12 exhibition. The term does not include rabbits, llamas, cattle, swine, sheep, goats, poultry or any other animal 13 that is used primarily for the production of food or fiber. 14 15 16 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2022.
