1 Subject to subsection (b) of this section, the state treasurer shall administer the university athletics 2 3 challenge account established under this article. The 4 following shall apply: 5 (b) Beginning July 1, 2024, the state treasurer shall 6 not make any matching qualifying contributions under this 7 8 article unless the University of Wyoming attains a student-athlete ratio of not less than thirty percent (30%) 9 10 of student athletes enrolled at the university who are 11 graduates of a Wyoming high school or Wyoming community 12 college and are participating in national collegiate 13 athletic association division one (1) intercollegiate athletics. The student-athlete ratio required for the state 14 treasurer to make matching qualifying contributions under 15 16 this subsection shall increase to forty percent (40%) beginning July 1, 2026 and shall increase to fifty percent 17 (50%) beginning July 1, 2028. 18 19 20 Section 2. Not later than July 1, 2023, the state 21 treasurer shall promulgate any rules necessary and the University of Wyoming shall take any action necessary to 22 23 implement this act.
