1	(a) In addition to any other fees and taxes provided
2	by law, an emergency response fee of two hundred dollars
3	(\$200.00) shall apply to each package of radioactive waste
4	transported through this state in accordance with W.S.
5	37-14-103. The department of transportation shall collect
6	this the emergency response fee based on assessed under
7	W.S. 37-14-103(a) when it issues a permit issued by the
8	department which is not inconsistent with federal law for
9	each package of radioactive materials transported through
10	this state. The department shall promulgate rules on
11	issuing and revoking permits which that are not
12	inconsistent with federal law. The department shall
13	promulgate rules on quarterly reporting and payment of
14	fees, retention of records and audit requirements. All The
15	emergency response fees fee collected under this subsection
16	pursuant to W.S. 37-14-103(a) shall be deposited in the

1 to each package of radioactive materials transported 2 through this state. The department of transportation shall 3 collect this fee based on a permit issued by the department 4 which is not inconsistent with federal law. The department shall promulgate rules on issuing and revoking permits 5 which are not inconsistent with federal law. The department 6 7 shall promulgate rules on quarterly reporting and payment 8 of fees, retention of records and audit requirements when 9 it issues a permit under W.S. 31-18-407(a). All emergency 10 response fees collected by the department of transportation pursuant to this subsection and W.S. 31-18-407(a) shall be 11 12 deposited in a separate account to be used for the payment 13 of costs associated with training for and conducting emergency response procedures related to the transportation 14 of radioactive materials. 15
