A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to criminal procedure; authorizing the  
2 release of military member criminal history record  
3 information as specified; requiring military member  
4 fingerprinting as specified; and providing for an effective  
5 date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-19-106(a)(xv) and 7-19-201(a)(viii)  
10 are amended to read:

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12 **7-19-106. Access to, and dissemination of,**  
13 **information.**

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1           (a) Criminal history record information shall be  
2 disseminated by criminal justice agencies in this state,  
3 whether directly or through any intermediary, only to:

4

5           (xv) The military department for purposes of  
6 obtaining criminal history record information, including  
7 any completed investigations, on prospective employees, ~~or~~  
8 volunteers or military members serving in active duty or in  
9 the Wyoming national guard. The dissemination of criminal  
10 history record information authorized by this paragraph  
11 shall only occur if required by the department as a  
12 condition for employment with the department, for training,  
13 deployment or mobilization decisions or for security  
14 clearance matters;

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16           **7-19-201. State or national criminal history record**  
17 **information.**

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19           (a) The following persons shall be required to submit  
20 to fingerprinting in order to obtain state and national  
21 criminal history record information:

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1           (viii) Prospective employees of or volunteers  
2 with the Wyoming military department or active duty or  
3 Wyoming national guard military members if the department  
4 requires ~~prospective employees or volunteers, or both, to~~  
5 ~~submit to fingerprinting in order to obtain~~ state and  
6 national criminal history record information, including any  
7 completed investigations, as a condition for ~~a position~~  
8 employment with the department, for training, deployment or  
9 mobilization decisions or for security clearance matters;

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11           **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2022.
