1 ACT relating to corporations; amending statutory 2 provisions regulating decentralized autonomous 3 organizations; amending definitions; making technical corrections; amending the obligations of members and 4 5 dissociated members; amending factors for dissolution of a 6 decentralized autonomous organization; repealing 7 definitions and provisions related to decentralized 8 autonomous organizations; and providing for an effective 9 date.
