Unappropriated federal funds-reporting and limitations.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government; clarifying reporting requirements for notice of 2 3 potential acceptance or expenditure of federal funds in excess of amounts approved by legislative act; requiring 4 the express affirmative approval of the legislature before 5 the acceptance or expenditure of federal funds in excess of 6 7 amounts approved by legislative act; making conforming 8 amendments; repealing conflicting provisions; specifying 9 applicability; and providing for an effective date.

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11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 13 **Section 1**. W.S. 9-2-1005(a)(xi), (g)(intro) and by
- 14 creating a new paragraph (v) and 9-4-206(b)(intro) are

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15 amended to read:

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9-2-1005. Payment of warrants; budget powers of

3 governor; agency budgets; federal funds; new employees.

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5 (a) No warrant shall be drawn by the auditor or paid

6 by the treasurer:

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8 (xi) If the expenditure is requested from

9 federal revenues exceeding the amount authorized by a

10 legislative appropriation act except upon notice to the

11 legislature and approval of the governor as provided by

12 paragraph (b)(iii) and subsection (g) of this section and,

13 <u>if required by subsection (g) of this section</u>, approval of

14 the legislature;

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16 (q) No federal funds in excess of amounts approved by

17 any legislative appropriations act may be accepted or

18 expended until approved by the governor in writing and, if

19 the federal funds are subject to paragraphs (i) through

20 (iv) of this subsection, until expressly approved by the

21 <u>legislature</u>. If the governor <u>or the legislature</u> disapproves

22 the acceptance or expenditure of federal funds under this

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23 subsection and the federal funds are accepted or expended,

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- 1 the state auditor shall not draw any warrant nor shall the
- 2 state treasurer pay any warrant which that would result in
- 3 the disbursement of funds, directly or indirectly through
- 4 contracts for services, to the public or private entity
- 5 involved. For any acceptance or expenditure of federal
- 6 funds under this paragraph in excess of one million dollars
- 7 (\$1,000,000.00), the governor's office:

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- 9 (v) Shall, for any notice or report that is
- 10 required to be submitted to the legislature under this
- 11 <u>subsection</u>, <u>provide the notice or report in writing or by</u>
- 12 electronic means to each legislator of the legislature
- 13 within the time specified in this subsection for each class
- 14 of funds specified in this subsection.

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- 16 9-4-206. Disposition of revenue; cash accounts;
- investment of monies held by state institutions.

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- 19 (b) Supplemental additions to approved budgets for
- 20 acceptance and expenditure of federal funds authorized for
- 21 acceptance by the governor after notice is provided to the
- 22 legislature and to each legislator pursuant to W.S.
- 23 9-2-1005(g) and, if applicable, the additional requirements

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1 of W.S. 9-2-1005(g) have been met, shall be in writing, 2 signed by the governor or his designated representative 3 copies to the state auditor and state 4 department. If approval is required by the legislature under W.S. 9-2-1005(g), the governor shall provide copies 5 of the legislative act that provides the approval to the 6 state auditor and the state budget department. Upon 7 8 approval by the governor and, if required under W.S. 9-2-1005(g), by the legislature, federal revenue that is 9 10 accepted and which that will result in a saving 11 replacement of state monies to accomplish a budgeted 12 activity or function shall be transferred to the general 13 fund with appropriate explanation. If the provisions of W.S. 9-2-1005(g)(ii) or (iv)(A) or (B) are applicable, the 14 joint appropriations committee shall meet as 15 soon as 16 feasible and in all events not less later than ten (10) 17 days after the legislature has received the request from 18 governor. The committee shall vote whether the 19 recommend the legislature should meet in special session 20 pursuant to Wyoming Constitution Article 3, Section 7 to 21 consider the acceptance or expenditure of the federal funds. Upon receipt of the committee's recommendation, the 22 23 presiding officers of each house shall initiate a poll of

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- 1 the members of the legislature in accordance with rules of
- 2 the legislature for calling itself into special session.
- 3 The governor may not accept or expend the funds until the
- 4 <u>earlier of: legislature has expressly approved the</u>
- 5 acceptance or expenditure of the federal funds.

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- 7 **Section 2.** W.S. 9-2-1005(g)(iii) and 9-4-206(b)(i)
- 8 and (ii) are repealed.

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- 10 Section 3. This act shall apply to all federal funds
- 11 that are in excess of amounts approved by any legislative
- 12 appropriations act that may be accepted or expended by the
- 13 state of Wyoming pursuant to law on and after the effective
- 14 date of this act.

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- 16 **Section 4**. This act is effective immediately upon
- 17 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
- 18 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

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19 Constitution.
