23 (b) Any board of county commissioners shall submit the  
24 question of establishing a special district to the county clerk  
25 not later than the first Monday in June in even-numbered years for  
26 submission of the question of establishing the special district to  
27 the resident electors of the proposed district at the next primary  
28 election if:  
29

30 (ii) The board of county commissioners receives a  
31 petition for the establishment of a special district signed by  
32 qualified electors resident in the proposed district equal in  
33 number to at least fifteen percent (15%) of the voters resident in  
34 the proposed district who voted in the last general election. The  
35 county clerk shall verify the signatures before consideration by  
36 the board pursuant to this paragraph. The petition shall state:

38 (D) The senior citizen programs and services that  
39 the proposed district will provide in the proposed district.  
40

41 (c) The ballot proposition for formation of a district shall  
42 appear substantially as follows:  
43

1 Shall the (name of district) senior citizen service  
2 district be established to provide the following  
3 programs and services (listing of the proposed programs  
4 and services), with a maximum levy of .... mills (not to  
5 exceed two (2) mills) to be imposed on the taxable  
6 property of the district?

10 (d) If the proposition to authorize a mill levy and to  
11 provide the specified proposed programs and services is approved  
12 by the qualified electors of the proposed district, the proposition  
13 to impose a levy in the same or at a different amount not to exceed  
14 two (2) mills, shall be submitted to the resident electors within  
15 the proposed district at the first general election held two (2)  
16 years after the election authorizing the district and every four  
17 (4) years thereafter, until defeated. If the proposition to impose  
18 or continue a mill levy is defeated, the proposition shall not be  
19 submitted to the electors for a period of not less than one (1)  
20 year."

27 "(c) Except as provided in subsection (d) of this section,  
28 any senior citizen service district seeking to expand the services  
29 provided by the district using the revenues collected under the  
30 tax levy authorized by W.S. 18-15-110 on or after July 1, 2023  
31 shall not provide the additional programs or services until the  
32 next time a ballot proposition to impose or renew a mill levy is  
33 submitted to the resident electors as required by this chapter.  
34 The question of the proposed expansion or addition of district  
35 programs and services shall be included as a ballot proposition on  
36 the ballot for imposing or renewing a mill levy.

37  
38 (d) Between July 1, 2023 and the date on which a district is  
39 required to renew a mill levy in accordance with this chapter, a  
40 district may designate and provide additional senior citizen  
41 service district programs or services under this chapter. The  
42 provision of additional programs or services under this subsection  
43 shall be in accordance with all of the following:

44  
45 (i) Before providing the additional services or  
46 programs, the district shall:

1 (A) Determine the anticipated expenditures for the  
2 proposed additional programs or services;

3  
4 (B) Hold a public hearing on the proposed  
5 additional programs or services;

6  
7 (C) Publish a description of the proposed  
8 additional programs or services and the date, time and place of  
9 the public hearing not less than one (1) time in a newspaper of  
10 general circulation in the district and not later than thirty (30)  
11 days before the public hearing;

12  
13 (D) Maintain a balance of not less than four million  
14 dollars (\$4,000,000.00) in the account established for the  
15 district under subsection (a) of this section at the time the  
16 additional programs or services are proposed.

17  
18 (ii) The additional programs or services provided under  
19 this subsection shall only use existing revenues of the district;

20  
21 (iii) The provision of additional programs or services  
22 shall cease if the ballot proposition for providing the additional  
23 programs or services is not adopted at the election for imposing  
24 or renewing a mill levy under this chapter."
