13 **"31-2-204. Issuance of certificates of registration and**
14 **license plates by county; form.**

16 (b) Except as otherwise provided, license plates shall be of
17 metal not less than twelve (12) inches long in the left-hand end
18 of which shall be arabic numerals for the county in which issued,
19 followed by the bucking horse and rider emblem and a distinctive
20 number assigned to the vehicle, set forth in numerals and letters
21 as determined by the department and above or underneath such
22 numerals shall be the word "Wyoming" and arabic numerals for the
23 year of issue or validation. License plates issued to dealers and
24 for state or federal official forestry vehicles, motorcycles,
25 multipurpose vehicles, permanently registered vehicles and
26 trailers shall contain appropriate identification which may be in
27 lieu of the bucking horse and rider emblem. After the county number
28 on the left-hand end, the license plate may also contain a
29 distinctive symbol or letters, as determined by the department,
30 indicating vehicle type. License plates shall be changed or
31 validated annually. There shall be a marked contrast between the
32 color of the plate and that of the numerals and letters and the
33 background of all plates shall be fully reflectorized. Plates for
34 light utility trailers under one thousand (1,000) pounds,
35 motorcycles and multipurpose vehicles shall not be less than three
36 (3) inches wide and six (6) inches long. Antique license plates
37 shall bear no date and shall bear the inscription "Pioneer Wyo".
38 License plates for permanent registration shall bear no date, shall
39 bear the inscription "Permanent" and the department shall
40 prescribe the design of the permanent registration license plate.
41 Distinctive license farm stickers shall be issued by the county
42 treasurer upon request for trucks and trailers used by any farmer
43 or rancher for the transportation of livestock, feed or unprocessed
44 agricultural products owned and produced by the farmer or rancher

1 from the place of production to market and of ranch supplies
2 intended solely for the use of the farmer or rancher, and not for
3 sale, on the return trip, and not for the transportation of goods
4 and persons for hire. Farm stickers shall bear the inscription
5 "Farm".".

16 (b) The department may issue license plates, except dealer,
17 permanent and antique motor vehicle license plates, which shall be
18 valid for not more than eight (8) years if annual validation
19 stickers are attached in the upper left corner of the license plate
20 with the month and year of expiration clearly visible. Department
21 authorized license plates and annual stickers shall be of colors
22 that are readily distinguishable from the previous year.".
