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11           "(k) In providing services under this section, the division

14           (i) Develop and provide computer and information  
15 technology services to agencies, the judiciary and the  
16 legislature, subject to subsection (h) of this section. Central  
17 delivery of common services shall be promoted to the extent they  
18 encourage a more economical and efficient operation of state  
19 programs while maintaining a compatibility of hardware and  
20 software among agencies, the legislature and the judiciary;

21  
22           (ii) Upon request of an agency, provide information and  
23 recommendations regarding the installation and acquisition of  
24 computer and information technology equipment, the qualifications  
25 of information technology personnel and software systems required  
26 by the agency. The information and recommendations provided under  
27 this paragraph shall be directed to advising the agency how to  
28 comply with uniform standards, minimize duplication and promote  
29 effectiveness in the collection, storage, interchange, retrieval,  
30 processing and transmission of information;

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32           (iii) Upon request of an agency, provide enterprise data  
33 analytics services;

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35           (iv) Provide data analytics security services and  
36 validation services, as directed by the governor;
