8 (I) Salaries for all school and district
9 level staffing categories, including teachers, principals and
10 assistant principals, central office administrators, secretarial
11 and clerical staff, operations and maintenance staff and aides and
12 media technicians, shall be based upon average statewide salary
13 levels calibrated under "Attachment A" for each staffing category,
14 adjusted under subsection (o) of this section, including the
15 experience, education and responsibility level as appropriate and
16 as computed for each staffing category. The statewide average for
17 each staffing category shall be adjusted for each district based
18 upon the district experience, education and responsibility level
19 relative to the statewide average for that category. District
20 experience, education and responsibility level by appropriate
21 staffing category shall be updated each year such that district
22 adjustments reflect the prior school year staffing information;
23

24 (II) The district adjusted average salary for
25 each staffing category computed under subdivision (I) of this
26 subparagraph shall be further adjusted for regional cost
27 differences as measured by the greater of the hedonic wage index
28 or the Wyoming cost-of-living index computed by the division of
29 economic analysis, department of administration and information,
30 with a minimum of one hundred (100) index value, as prescribed by
31 the education resource block grant model. For purposes of the
32 education resource block grant model, the version of the Wyoming
33 cost-of-living index used by the division shall be based upon the
34 unrecalibrated housing cost index weights unless otherwise
35 determined by the legislature based upon recommendation of the
36 joint education interim committee. In addition, the version of
37 the Wyoming cost-of-living index applied under this subparagraph
38 for any school year shall be the greater of the average of the six
39 (6) consecutive semi-annual index reports completed by January 1
40 of the immediately preceding school year or the semi-annual index
41 report completed by January 1 of this immediately preceding school
42 year. This subdivision is repealed July 1, 2026;
