3                   "(iii) If the subdivision is in an ungulate wildlife  
4 migration corridor, any fence constructed shall be constructed in  
5 an animal friendly manner that:  
6

7                   (A) For wire fencing, shall mean that the top wire  
8 be smooth and not more than forty-two (42) inches above grade,  
9 with a middle wire not less than twelve (12) inches below the top  
10 wire and a smooth bottom wire not less than eighteen (18) inches  
11 above grade;  
12

13                   (B) For buck and pole fencing, shall mean that  
14 every other section of fencing shall either have only two (2) poles  
15 between and on the same side of the bucks, with the top pole not  
16 more than forty-two (42) inches above grade and the bottom pole  
17 not less than eighteen (18) inches above grade;  
18

19                   (C) For any other fence construction in an  
20 ungulate migration corridor, it may be used if it is animal  
21 friendly. As used in this paragraph, "animal friendly" means that  
22 ungulate wildlife can traverse a fence without undue risk of  
23 injury."
