The Wyoming community revitalization account is created. The state treasurer may accept federal grants and other contributions, grants, gifts, transfers, bequests and donations of money from any source for deposit into the account. Funds within the account shall only be expended upon legislative appropriation. All funds within the account shall be invested by the state treasurer in accordance with law and all investment earnings from the account shall be credited to the general funds.".

Page 10-line 1

After "provided." insert "Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008, 9-2-1012(e) and 9-4-207, the first five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) of unexpended, unobligated funds appropriated from the general fund remaining upon completion of a project shall revert to the Wyoming community revitalization account created under W.S. 9-4-227."

Page 17-after line 2 Insert:

 "(b) There is appropriated up to five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) or as much thereof as is available from the community revitalization account to the Wyoming business council for purposes of providing grants for revitalization and beautification of historic downtown areas. The grant recipients that qualify under this subsection shall be selected by the business council and approved by the state loan and investment board, subject to the following:

(i) Any one (1) city shall not receive more than one (1)
grant and the grant awarded shall not exceed one million dollars
(\$1,000,000.00);

(ii) Expenditure of any grant by a recipient is conditioned upon a cash match of funds in the ratio of one dollar (\$1.00) of grant funds to not less than one dollar (\$1.00) from any other source;
