Page 1-line 2 After "requirements" insert "that negatively impact the people or any jurisdiction in Wyoming".

Page 2-line 1 Before "The" insert "Notwithstanding the applicable provisions of the United States constitution and the Wyoming constitution,".

Page 2-line 2 After "shall" delete balance of line.

Page 2-lines 3 through 7 Delete entirely and insert "not impose any requirements or health related mandates that negatively impact the health and public safety of any person including any jurisdiction, county, city or town in Wyoming. After the department of health reviews the United States centers for disease control and prevention or the World Health Organization's requirements and makes a recommendation to the governor of Wyoming for final approval then the requirements may be imposed.".

Page 2-line 9 Delete "July 1, 2023" and insert "immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become

law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
