A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to cities and towns; providing that elected  
2 and appointed officers may elect not to receive a salary or  
3 compensation while serving as elected or appointed  
4 officers; providing legislative intent; and providing for  
5 an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 15-2-103 and 15-3-205 by creating a  
10 new subsection (c) are amended to read:

12 **15-2-103. Officers; salaries.**

## CORRECTED COPY

1 The governing body shall fix the salaries for the mayor and  
2 councilmen in towns not operating under the commission or  
3 city manager form of government. The salaries shall be  
4 fixed before their terms begin and shall not change during  
5 the term for which they are elected. The salary for mayor  
6 shall be paid in twelve (12) or more installments and may  
7 not exceed the maximum of twenty-four thousand dollars  
8 (\$24,000.00) per year. The salary for each councilman shall  
9 be not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than one  
10 hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) for actual attendance at  
11 each regular or special meeting. All appointed officers  
12 shall receive the salary or compensation as provided by law  
13 or ordinance. Any elected or appointed officers who are  
14 entitled to receive a salary or compensation under this  
15 section may elect, upon written notice submitted not less  
16 than two (2) weeks in advance of being paid, not to receive  
17 all or a portion of the salary or compensation at any time  
18 during their term.
