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12 **22-1-102.** Definitions.

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- 14 (a) The definitions contained in this chapter apply
- 15 to words and phrases used in this Election Code and govern

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- 1 the construction of those words and phrases unless they are
- 2 specifically modified by the context in which they appear.
- 3 As used in this Election Code:

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- 5 (xxix) "Registry list" is the list by precinct
- 6 of the names, addresses, party affiliations, unique
- 7 identifying numbers generated by the state, information
- 8 relating to absentee ballot status, registration dates and
- 9 precinct and district numbers of the registered electors in
- 10 the county prepared by the secretary of state or county
- 11 clerks for distribution as provided in W.S. 22-2-113;

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- 13 22-2-113. Availability and form of registry lists;
- 14 use of copies; election record; purging.

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- 16 (d) Unless otherwise specifically stated in this
- 17 Election Code, all election records of the county clerk are
- 18 public. The availability and dissemination of such records
- 19 shall be in accordance with the Wyoming Public Records Act.
- 20 Election records containing social security numbers,
- 21 portions of social security numbers, driver's license
- 22 numbers, birth dates, telephone numbers, tribal
- 23 identification card numbers, e-mail addresses and other
