5	rustling, any other theft offense under this section, any
6	theft offense under a municipal ordinance or any theft
7	offense pursuant to a substantially similar law of another
8	jurisdiction separately brought and tried shall be guilty
9	of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than
10	ten (10) years, a fine of not more than ten thousand
11	dollars (\$10,000.00), or both.
