School crosswalks and pedestrian crossings-appropriation.

Sponsored by: Joint Judiciary Interim Committee

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government;
2 providing an appropriation for purposes of grants for
3 school crosswalk improvement and pedestrian bridge
4 planning, design and construction; specifying conditions
5 for grants; and providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.**

10

11 (a) There is appropriated ten million dollars
12 (\$10,000,000.00) from the general fund to the Wyoming
13 department of transportation for the period beginning with
14 the effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2028 to
15 be expended only for purposes of providing funds for school
16 crosswalk projects on state highways and for school

1 crosswalk projects on roadways of cities, towns and
2 counties in accordance with subsection (b) of this section
3 and for administrative expenses in accordance with
4 subsection (c) of this section. This appropriation shall
5 not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and
6 any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this
7 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,
8 2028. It is the intent of the legislature that this
9 appropriation not be included in the standard budget of the
10 department of transportation for any immediately succeeding
11 fiscal biennium.

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13 (b) The department of transportation shall expend or
14 distribute funds appropriated under subsection (a) of this
15 section to cities, towns, counties, agencies, political
16 subdivisions and any other entity of the state in
17 accordance with the following:

18

19 (i) Funds shall only be expended by the
20 department, cities, towns, counties, agencies, political
21 subdivisions and any other entity of the state on
22 improvements to crosswalks identified in a local
23 transportation plan that support safe routes to school or

1 that are located within school zones where the speed limit
2 is reduced in accordance with W.S. 31-5-301(b)(i) or where
3 the crosswalk is immediately adjacent to a school facility.
4 For purposes of this paragraph, improvements to crosswalks
5 shall include:

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7 (A) Planning, design, construction and
8 installation of pedestrian overpasses;

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10 (B) Planning, design, construction and
11 installation of pedestrian underpasses or tunnels;

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13 (C) Improvements to existing school
14 crosswalks, including improvements to existing pedestrian
15 overpasses, pedestrian underpasses, signage, signals,
16 lighting and the roadway adjacent to school crosswalks.

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18 (ii) The department shall prioritize the
19 expenditure and distribution of funds for school crosswalks
20 in the following order:

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22 (A) School crosswalks where a fatality has
23 occurred within the last two (2) years;

2 (B) School crosswalks where an injury or
3 other accident has occurred within the last two (2) years;

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5 (C) Any other school crosswalk where the
6 department determines that there is a need for an
7 improvement specified in paragraph (i) of this subsection;

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9 (D) Any school crosswalk identified in a
10 local transportation plan.

11

12 (iii) Before allowing expenditure of the funds
13 appropriated under this section, the department shall
14 require any city, town, county, agency, political
15 subdivision or any other entity of the state participating
16 in the grant program to provide not less than a twenty-five
17 percent (25%) match of any funds to be expended;

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19 (iv) Projects for school crosswalks shall be
20 completed not later than June 30, 2028.

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1 (c) The distribution of funds appropriated under this
2 act shall be in the same manner as the department currently
3 administers the transportation alternatives program.

5 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
6 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
7 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
8 Constitution.
