Description of appropriation:

The legislation covers the stand-up costs with additional FTEs and appropriates \$460,000 per year for four years with a total expenditure of \$1.84 million. These costs are broken down annually to include:

- (A) Existing, Uranium Program Manager cost of (50%) = \$81,000 per year;
- (B) Two (2) new ENNR11 technical positions (\$184,500 \* 2) = \$369,000 per year;
- (C) Consulting and support services = \$10,000 per year

Following completion of the program amendment stand-up, which is anticipated at the end of FY 2027, the program will be transitioned to an industry fee-based structure. The annual estimated operational expenditure of \$555,000 annually would be distributed pro-rata across the number of license holders at the time of stand-up.

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
