This bill reestablishes the Wyoming Teacher Shortage Loan Repayment Program (program) and expands the eligible areas for teachers and endorsement categories to be considered for the program. The Commission notes that while it anticipates expending the full appropriation during FY 2024, expenditures will be dependent upon the demand for the program, which may begin as soon as fall 2023. It anticipates utilizing 5 percent (\$25,000) of the appropriation for administration costs and the remainder (\$475,000) for loans to eligible students.
