Source of expenditure increase:

Game and Fish Department personnel time spent modifying and implementing Game and Fish Commission regulations to align with the bill.

Assumptions:

The Game and Fish Department assumes approximately twenty (20) hours at a cost of seventy dollars (\$70) per hour will be required to modify all Commission regulations pertinent to the bill and go through the public comment and Commission approval process, for a total expenditure increase of 20 x \$70 = \$1,400.

The expenditure increase reflected above could be considered an administrative cost. However, for simplicity and to follow consistent practice on legislation of this type, it is included on the fiscal note.

The fiscal impact to the judicial system is indeterminable due to an unknown number of cases.
