Permanent mineral trust fund-distributions and investments.

FISCAL NOTE

The Secretary of State's Office will experience an estimated expenditure increase of approximately \$98,000 for this resolution in FY25 for statutory publication costs. This estimate is based on anticipated publication costs for resolutions of this type of \$16,000 for introductory lines plus \$2,000 for each line of text in the proposed resolution and proposed ballot language.
