## FISCAL NOTE

This bill authorizes payment for services rendered by a licensed pharmacist under the Medical Assistance and Services.

The Department of Health and Board of Pharmacy reported no significant fiscal or personnel impact if this legislation were enacted.

## Assumptions:

If this legislation were enacted, the Department of Health estimates a net zero change in expenditures. The Department of Health assumes expenditures would shift from inpatient events or hospitalizations to medication therapy management services provided by licensed pharmacists. As such, any increased expenditure for services from licensed pharmacists would be offset by reductions in other medical services paid from within the same budget unit.

Wyoming's experience will be similar to other states for this type of coverage.
