Members of the Commission shall serve without salary but shall receive per diem and mileage or actual expenses for attending meetings in the manner and amounts provided by law for state employees. Members who are government employees shall be considered on official business of their agency when performing duties as members of the commission. The Wyoming Department is charged to provide the necessary clerical and administrative support for the Commission.
