1 ACT relating to the consolidated school facility AN remediation schedule for public schools; eliminating the 2 consolidated remediation index and associated rulemaking 3 4 authority; and providing for an effective date. 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 6 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-15-117(a)(intro) is amended to 8 9 read: 10 11 21-15-117. Annual evaluation of school buildings and facilities; remediation schedules; needs prioritization; 12 13 combining facilities; implementation of remedy. 14 15 (a) The commission shall annually evaluate the 16 adequacy of school buildings and facilities and prioritize

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1 school building and facility needs in accordance with this subsection. The commission shall cause the department, as 2 3 it deems necessary, to conduct periodic on-site visitations 4 and inspections of school buildings and facilities and acquire other relevant needs assessment data acquired in 5 coordination and cooperation with the districts for 6 purposes of this evaluation and prioritization. 7 The commission shall give due consideration to district 8 9 facility plans developed under W.S. 21-15-116 in performing 10 this evaluation and prioritization. To conduct the evaluation and prioritization, the commission 11 shall 12 establish two (2) schedules for building and facility 13 remediation on a statewide basis using appropriate scoring systems, as described in paragraphs (i) and (iii) of this 14 15 subsection. Under each of the two (2) schedules the 16 commission shall prioritize educational building and facility needs that impede the delivery of the prescribed 17 Additionally, the 18 statewide educational program. 19 commission shall establish one (1) consolidated remediation 20 schedule as described in paragraph (vi) of this subsection. 21 The commission shall by rule and regulation establish a process to prioritize all school building and facility 22 23 needs from the most critical to the least critical with the

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1	most critical need prioritized first. Remediation
2	undertaken under these schedules shall over time bring all
3	buildings and facilities to the levels set by the statewide
4	adequacy standards promulgated under W.S. 21-15-115(a). The
5	commission shall annually develop:
