A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to child care facilities; providing an  
2 exception to child care facility certification for  
3 specified part-time preschool facilities; requiring  
4 rulemaking; and providing for effective dates.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 14-4-102(b) by creating a new  
9 paragraph (xi) is amended to read:

10

11 **14-4-102. Certification required; exceptions.**

13 (b) W.S. 14-4-101 through 14-4-111 do not apply to:

14

1           (xi) Part-time preschool facilities enrolling  
2 fewer than eight (8) minors who are all over thirty-six  
3 (36) months old or fewer than ten (10) minors who are all  
4 over forty-eight (48) months old if the facility:

5  
6           (A) Does not administer medications to the  
7 minors;

8  
9           (B) Does not prepare food for the minors;

10  
11           (C) Requires the minors to be trained and  
12 able to use a toilet and not wear diapers;

13  
14           (D) Limits the minors to no more than ten  
15 (10) hours of preschool attendance each week; and

16  
17           (E) Adheres to all applicable local health,  
18 safety and fire codes or regulations.

19  
20           **Section 2.** The department of family services shall  
21 promulgate rules necessary to implement this act.

3           (a) Except as otherwise provided by subsection (b) of  
4 this section, this act is effective July 1, 2023.

5

6           (b) Sections 2 and 3 of this act are effective  
7 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a  
8 bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of  
9 the Wyoming Constitution.
