1 through the division as provided in W.S. 12-2-203(g) or 2 12-4-201(j) shall, before the transfer of the product, to a 3 satellite location, remit to the division an assessment in 4 an amount equal to the profit allowed under subsection (a) of this section and the associated excise tax assessed 5 under W.S. 12-3-101 that would have been received by the 6 division had the holder of a manufacturer's license first 7 8 obtained the alcoholic liquor from the division as provided in subsection (a) of this section. The department shall by 9 10 rule define the procedure under which a holder of a manufacturer's license shall report and remit the 11 12 assessment under this subsection.
