A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to public health and safety; prohibiting
2 health mandates and requirements by specified federal and
3 nongovernmental health organizations as specified; and
4 providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-4-1001 is created to read:

10 ARTICLE 10

11 PROHIBITED HEALTH ORGANIZATIONS

13 **35-4-1001. Consideration and compliance with**
14 **specified health organizations; limitations.**

1 The United States centers for disease control and
2 prevention and the World Health Organization shall have no
3 jurisdiction in Wyoming and any requirements, mandates,
4 recommendations, instructions or guidance provided by
5 either organization shall not be used in this state to
6 justify any mask, vaccine or medical testing requirements
7 and shall have no force or effect in Wyoming.

9 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2023.
