9 **Section 1.** W.S. 28-7-101 by creating a new subsection

12 **28-7-101.** Registration; reports.

1	(d) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection,
2	a former state legislator shall not become a lobbyist or
3	engage in lobbying that would require registration under
4	subsection (b) of this section for two (2) years, beginning
5	on the day the state legislator's terms ends after not
6	being again elected to the state legislator's office or
7	having otherwise been removed from office and ending on the
8	two (2) year anniversary of that day. This subsection shall
9	not apply if the former state legislator engages in
10	lobbying on the former state legislator's own behalf.
11	
12	28-7-102. Penalties.
13	
14	(a) Any person or individual failing to register as a
15	lobbyist with the secretary of state or who violates W.S.
16	28-7-101(d) shall be guilty of a misdemeanor subject to a
17	fine of not more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) five
18	thousand dollars (\$5,000.00).
