(d) A person who trespasses to unlawfully collect 5 6 resource data $_{\tau}$ or a person who unlawfully collects resource data or a person who trespasses to access adjacent or 7 proximate land under this section shall be liable in a 8 9 civil action by the owner or lessee of the land for all 10 consequential and economic damages proximately caused by 11 the trespass. In a civil action brought under this 12 section, in addition to damages, a successful claimant 13 shall be awarded litigation costs. For purposes of this subsection, "litigation costs" shall include, but is are 14 not limited to, court costs, expert witness fees, other 15 16 witness fees, costs associated with depositions and 17 discovery, reasonable attorney fees and the reasonably 18 necessary costs of identifying the trespasser, of obtaining 19 effective service of process on the trespasser and of 20 successfully effecting the collection of any judgment 21 against the trespasser.
