W.S. 34-1-158 is created to read: 10 11 34-1-158. Prescriptive easement for water conveyance. 12 13 (a) A prescriptive easement for a water conveyance may be established if a water user has used and maintained 14 15 a water conveyance under a claim of right for a period of 16 ten (10) years during which the use has been:

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1 2 (i) Continuous and uninterrupted; 3 4 (ii) Open and notorious; and 5 б (iii) Adverse. 7 8 (b) If a water user establishes paragraphs (a)(i) and (ii) of this section, there is a rebuttable presumption 9 10 that the use has been adverse under paragraph (a)(iii). 11 12 (c) The holder of a prescriptive easement for a water conveyance established as provided in subsections (a) and 13 14 (b) may: 15 16 (i) File a notice describing the prescriptive 17 easement consistent with the requirements of W.S. 34-1-141 in the office of the county clerk in which the prescriptive 18 19 easement or a portion of the easement is located; 20 21 (ii) Access, use, maintain and repair the water conveyance located within the easement in accordance with 22 23 law.

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1 2 (d) As used in this section: 3 4 (i) "Water conveyance" means a canal, ditch, drain ditch, pipeline or other means of conveying water; 5 6 7 (ii) "Water user" means a water user or the water user's predecessor who owns an adjudicated or valid 8 9 unadjudicated water right being conveyed in a water 10 conveyance. 11 (e) The state engineer's office shall maintain and 12 post to its website an informational document regarding 13 legal aspects related to water conveyance easements. This 14 document shall not constitute legal advice. All real estate 15 16 transactions involving property through which a water 17 conveyance passes through shall include notice of this 18 document. 19

20 Section 2. Nothing in this act shall be construed to 21 interfere with or modify any existing easement or property 22 right, including a valid water right, nor alter any rights

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1 or duties associated with any existing easement or property
2 right, as established by law.
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4 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2023.
