1 AN ACT relating to courts; providing for the digitizing and 2 retention of court records as specified; striking obsolete 3 language; and providing for an effective date. 4 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 6 Section 1. W.S. 5-7-103 is amended to read: 7 8 9 5-7-103. Filing, preserving and use of papers; 10 electronic record retention permitted. 11 12 The clerk shall file together and carefully preserve in his 13 office, all papers delivered to him for that purpose in every action or proceeding. He shall not permit the papers 14 to be taken from his office except to be used at a session 15

1 of the court or upon legal process, and he shall be liable 2 upon his official bond to the party suffering injury on 3 account of any violation of this section. This section 4 shall not apply to matters in probate. Upon the order of the judge of the district, the clerk may transmit by 5 express or registered mail to an attorney of the state 6 7 appearing in the action or proceeding, who resides in a 8 different county or away from the county seat, such original files as are not represented by copies in the 9 10 clerk's office, and the clerk shall take the attorney's 11 receipt for each paper in each case. Nothing in this 12 section shall limit or prohibit the clerk from microfilming scanning or digitizing papers, in his office, disposing of 13 the originals in accordance with W.S. 9-2-411 any rule or 14 15 order issued by the supreme court and retaining the 16 official microfilm digitized or imaged records in a case 17 management system in lieu of retaining the original papers pursuant to W.S. 9-2-413 in a physical file. 18
