A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to legal time and holidays; designating
2 Moon Landing Day as a state recognized commemorative day to
3 be observed as specified; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 8-4-116 is created to read:

9

10 **8-4-116. Moon Landing Day.**

12 (a) In recognition of American astronauts Neil
13 Armstrong and Edwin "Buzz" Aldrin becoming the first humans
14 to land and walk on the moon on July 20, 1969 and the men
15 and women who aided the astronauts in landing on the moon

1 and returning home safely, July 20 of each year is
2 designated as "Moon Landing Day." The day shall be
3 appropriately observed by state and local government and by
4 organizations within the state.

5

6 (b) The governor shall, in advance of July 20 of each
7 year, issue a proclamation requesting proper observance of
8 "Moon Landing Day."

9

10 (c) This section shall not affect commercial paper,
11 the making or execution of agreements or judicial
12 proceedings, or authorize public schools, businesses or
13 state and local government offices to close.

14

15 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2023.
