## A BILL

## for

1 AN ACT relating to the insurance code; providing for 2 dentists to bill and collect payment from insureds for 3 services performed as specified; prohibiting bundling of 4 dental procedures for billing purposes; prohibiting 5 downcoding of dental procedures for billing purposes; 6 providing definitions; making conforming amendments; 7 specifying applicability; and providing for an effective 8 date.

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10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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Section 1. W.S. 26-22-505(a), (b), by creating a new subsection (c) and by renumbering (c) as (d) is amended to read:

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1 26-22-505. Dental insurance; limitation on fee 2 schedules for covered and noncovered services; billing for 3 services; definition; applicability. 4 5 (a) No person, or entity or insurer contracting with dentists to provide coverage or reimbursement for dental 6 services shall require a dentist to provide services at a 7 8 fee set by the contract, a policy or a certificate unless the services are covered services by the terms of the 9 10 contract, policy or certificate. 11 12 (b) For purposes of this section:  $\overline{t}$ 13 (i) "Bundling" means the practice of combining 14 15 separate dental procedures into one (1) procedure for 16 billing purposes; 17 18 (ii) "Covered services" means services 19 reimbursable under the contract, policy or certificate, 20 subject to customary contractual limitations on benefits including such items as deductibles, waiting periods, 21 frequency limitations or charges over the benefit maximum; 22

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1	(iii) "Downcoding" means the adjustment of a
2	claim for a dental procedure submitted to an insurer to a
3	less complex or lower cost procedure.
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5	(c) No person, entity or insurer contracting with
6	dentists to provide coverage or reimbursement for dental
7	services under the terms of a contract, a policy or a
8	certificate shall:
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10	(i) Prohibit a dentist from billing and
11	collecting payment from an insured for a service the
12	dentist performs that may not be a covered service by the
13	contract, policy or certificate, if the dentist:
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15	(A) Notifies the insured that the dentist
16	may not receive full reimbursement or payment from the
17	contracting person, entity or insurer;
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19	(B) Informs the insured that the insured is
20	responsible for payment of the service or any remaining
21	balance after all insurance payments;
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1	(C) Obtains the insured's written consent
2	to perform the service; and
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4	(D) Provides a copy of the insured's
5	written consent to perform the service to the contracting
6	person, entity or insurer upon request.
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8	(ii) Use bundling in a manner where a procedure
9	that normally would be billed to the insured would not be
10	billed to the insured unless, under generally accepted
11	medical and dental guidelines, the procedure may be
12	provided in conjunction with another procedure;
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14	(iii) Use downcoding in a manner that prevents a
15	dentist from billing for the actual service performed and
16	collecting payment from the insurer, the insured or both.
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18	<pre>(c)(d) This section shall apply to contracts,</pre>
19	policies or certificates issued, renewed, delivered or
20	issued for delivery in this state on or after July 1, 2011.
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Section 2. This act shall apply to all contracts,
policies or certificates issued, renewed or delivered on or
after July 1, 2023.
Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2023.
