A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to criminal history records; clarifying  
2 that criminal history record information shall be  
3 disseminated to the board of occupational therapy as  
4 specified; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-19-106(a)(xxxviii) and  
9 7-19-201(a)(xxxiii) are amended to read:

11 **7-19-106. Access to, and dissemination of,**  
12 **information.**

13

14 (a) Criminal history record information shall be  
15 disseminated by criminal justice agencies in this state,  
16 whether directly or through any intermediary, only to:

2 (xxxviii) The board of occupational therapy for  
3 purposes of obtaining background information on ~~persons~~  
4 currently licensed occupational therapists and occupational  
5 therapist assistants applying for a compact privilege under  
6 the Occupational Therapy Licensure Compact as provided in  
7 W.S. 33-40-201 through 33-40-216;

9 **7-19-201. State or national criminal history record**  
10 **information.**

11

12 (a) The following persons shall be required to submit  
13 to fingerprinting in order to obtain state and national  
14 criminal history record information:

15

16 (xxxiii) All ~~persons~~ currently licensed  
17 occupational therapists and occupational therapist  
18 assistants applying for a compact privilege under the  
19 Occupational Therapy Licensure Compact as provided in W.S.  
20 33-40-201 through 33-40-216.

1           **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon  
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
4 Constitution.
