W.S. 22-3-115(a)(vi), 22-5-212 and 22-5-214 are amended to read: 10 11 12 22-3-115. Grounds for cancellation of registration. 13 14 (a) A registered elector's registration shall be 15 cancelled for any one (1) of the following reasons:

2	(vi) Upon written request of the elector <mark>at any</mark>
3	time except for the period for which party changes are
4	prohibited as specified in W.S. 22-5-214.

6	22-5-212. When declaration of party affiliation
7	required.

9	An elector requesting a major party ballot <mark>must shall</mark>
10	declare his <mark>or change</mark> party affiliation, or sign an
11	application for change of affiliation in accordance with
12	<u>W.S. 22-5-214</u> before <u>he may receive</u> <u>receiving</u> a party
13	ballot. An elector may vote only the nonpartisan ballot and
14	if so, is not required to declare his party affiliation.
15	Requesting a partisan primary election ballot constitutes a
16	declaration of party affiliation. A change in declaration
17	of party affiliation shall be in accordance with the
18	requirements of W.S. 22-5-214 and shall be entered on the
19	poll list by the election judge.

1	(a) For a primary election, an elector may declare or
2	change party affiliation by completing an application
3	signed before a notarial officer or election official and
4	filing it with the county clerk prior to the first day on
5	which an application for nomination may be filed under W.S.
6	22-5-209.

8 (b) For a general election, an elector may declare or 9 change his party affiliation by completing an application signed before a notarial officer or election official, and 10 filing it with the county clerk after the primary election 11 12 and not less than fourteen (14) days before the primary general election or at the polls on the day of the primary 13 or general election, or when requesting an absentee ballot 14 15 for the general election.

17 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 18 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 19 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 20 Constitution.
