A JOINT RESOLUTION

for

A JOINT RESOLUTION to amend the Wyoming Constitution by
authorizing a homeowner's property tax exemption for the
elderly and infirm.

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5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING, 6 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting 7 separately, concurring therein:

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9 Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming 10 Constitution, Article 15 by creating a new Section 21 is 11 proposed for submission to the electors of the State of 12 Wyoming at the next general election for approval or rejection 13 to become valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by 14 a majority of the electors at the election:

1Article 15, Section 21. Homeowner's property tax2exemption for the elderly and infirm.

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4 Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, 5 residential property may be exempt from taxation to preserve 6 home ownership in Wyoming for the elderly and infirm if 7 necessary for the support of the poor. The legislature may 8 provide for residential property to be exempt from taxation 9 in whole or in part as it determines necessary for purposes 10 of this section.

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Section 2. That the Secretary of State shall endorse the following statement on the proposed amendment:

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15 The adoption of this amendment to the Wyoming Constitution 16 would provide that the legislature may provide for a property 17 tax exemption as it determines necessary to preserve home 18 ownership for the elderly and infirm if necessary for the 19 support of the poor.
