**Catch Title:** **Livestock infectious disease control-tribal inclusion.**

**Subject:** Livestock infectious disease control.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- This act specifies that livestock producers on the Wind River Indian Reservation may participate in state programs for livestock contagious and infectious reportable disease testing, containment and reimbursements.
- This act provides that testing, containment and reimbursement services on the Wind River Indian Reservation may be provided pursuant to a cooperative agreement entered into by the Wyoming Livestock Board, in consultation with the state veterinarian, and the Eastern Shoshone Tribe, the Northern Arapaho Tribe, both tribes or a cooperative governing body of the two (2) tribes.
- This act authorizes the Governor to negotiate with tribes of the regions adjacent to Wyoming on brucellosis containment.
