18 Page 2-line 9 Delete entirely and insert "the first sixty  
19 thousand dollars (\$60,000.00) of fair market  
20 value shall be exempt as a homestead  
21 exemption".

23 Page 2-lines 11 through 23 Delete entirely including the House  
24 standing committee amendment (HB0052HS001/A)  
25 to these lines.

27 Page 3-lines 1 through 3 Delete entirely including the House  
28 standing committee amendment (HB0052HS001/A)  
29 to these lines.

31 Page 3-lines 5 through 15 Delete entirely.

33 Page 3-line 17 Delete "(C)" and insert "(B)"; delete ":", and  
34 insert ", \"single family residential  
35 structure\" means a structure intended for  
36 human habitation including a house, modular  
37 home, mobile home, townhouse or condominium  
38 that is a privately owned single family  
39 dwelling unit.".

41 Page 3-lines 19 through 22 Delete entirely.

43 Page 4-lines 1 through 22 Delete entirely.

5 Page 6-after line 9 Insert:
