15 (d) of this section and after consultation with the state agency
16 or agencies receiving or administering investment earnings from
17 the monies invested under this subsection, may invest monies
18 comprising the following accounts in equities including stocks of
19 corporations in accordance with subsections (a) and (c) through
20 (e) of this section and W.S. 9-4-716. The state loan and investment
21 board, in consultation with the state agency or agencies receiving
22 or administering investment earnings from the monies invested from
23 the following accounts, shall annually review the state investment
24 policy statements for the accounts in this subsection as required
25 under W.S. 9-4-716. In adopting investment policy statements for
26 this investment pool, the board shall seek to preserve the balance
27 of each account in a manner that strives for the highest possible
28 risk-adjusted total net return consistent with an appropriate
29 level of safety and liquidity. Monies in the following funds shall
30 be invested in the pool B investment account:
