(c) For purposes of subsection (a) of this footnote, 1 2 "abortion": 3 4 (i) Shall include any instrument, medicine, drug or any 5 other substance, device or means administered with the intent to 6 terminate the clinically diagnosable pregnancy of a woman, including the elimination of one (1) or more unborn babies in a 7 multifetal pregnancy, with knowledge that the termination by those 8 9 means will, with reasonable likelihood, cause the death of the 10 unborn baby; 11 12 (ii) Shall not include any of the following: 13 14 (A) A procedure to save the life or preserve the 15 health of the unborn baby; 16 (B) A procedure to remove a dead unborn baby caused 17 18 by spontaneous abortion or intrauterine fetal demise; 19 20 (C) Treatment of a woman for an ectopic pregnancy; 21 or 22 23 (D) Treatment of a woman for cancer or another disease that requires medical treatment, which treatment may be 24 25 fatal or harmful to the unborn baby.".
