A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to public health and safety; prohibiting  
2 health mandates and requirements by specified federal and  
3 nongovernmental health organizations; and providing for an  
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-4-1001 is created to read:

10 ARTICLE 10

11 PROHIBITED HEALTH ORGANIZATIONS

13 **35-4-1001. Consideration and compliance with**  
14 **specified health organizations; limitations.**

2 The United States centers for disease control and  
3 prevention and the World Health Organization shall have no  
4 jurisdiction in Wyoming and any requirements, mandates,  
5 recommendations, instructions or guidance provided by  
6 either organization shall not be binding in this state to  
7 justify any mask, vaccine or medical testing requirements  
8 for COVID-19 and any variant thereof and shall have no  
9 force or effect in Wyoming.

11 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2024.
