14 actual live horse racing or pari-mutuel event days required

15 to qualify for a simulcasting permit. A live horse racing

1 less than six (6) horses per race. The commission shall 2 adopt rules governing establishment of live horse racing or 3 pari-mutuel event days required for a simulcasting permit 4 in a manner that ensures fair and equitable involvement of 5 affected parties, including consideration of all the economic viability of those days to permit applicants. For 6 7 pari-mutuel wagering on events that have previously 8 occurred, the simulcasting permit shall be limited as follows: 9 10 11 (i) No permit shall be issued for a location 12 that will have less than twenty (20) electronic devices for 13 pari-mutuel wagering; 14 15 The permit shall be limited to not more (ii) 16 than fifty (50) electronic devices for pari-mutuel wagering 17 for each day of live horse racing days required to qualify 18 for a simulcasting permit under this subsection. If the 19 number of live horse racing days required to qualify for a 20 simulcasting permit under this subsection is not met in any 21 calendar year, in the following calendar year the permit holder shall reduce the number of electronic devices 22 23 utilized by the permit holder by fifty (50) for each day of
