AN ACT relating to state funded capital construction; providing 1 definitions; providing appropriations for purposes related to 2 state funded capital construction; making appropriations subject 3 to terms and conditions as specified; providing matching funds 4 5 for specified projects; providing for the acquisition or acceptance of real property; authorizing the expenditure of 6 7 appropriations as specified; reverting a prior prior appropriation; and providing for an effective date. 8

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

14 (a) As used in this act:

1 (i) "Appropriation" means the authorizations granted by the legislature under this act to make expenditures from and 2 to incur obligations against the general and other funds as 3 specified; 4 5 6 (ii) "FF" means federal funds; 7 8 (iii) "PR" means private funding sources; 9 10 (iv) "SR" means an agency's account within the special revenue fund; 11 12 13 (v) "S0" means other funds identified by footnote; 14 15 (vi) "S13" means the strategic investments and 16 projects account. 17 18 (b) Appropriations for projects in this act remain in 19 effect until the project is completed, unless otherwise provided. The amounts appropriated for projects under this act 20 shall be expended only on the projects specified and any 21 22 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining upon completion of a

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project shall revert to the accounts from which they were

1 appropriated, unless otherwise provided. The amounts

2 appropriated in this act are intended to provide a maximum

3 amount for each project from any source excluding contingency

4 funding and shall not be construed to be an entitlement or

5 guaranteed amount.

The Gillette community college district is authorized to acquire or accept the transfer of ownership from the city of Gillette of five (5) facilities totaling approximately seventy-eight thousand six hundred fifty-three (78,653) square feet consisting of the carter health science center, tanner village 1, tanner village 2, tanner village 3 and inspiration hall.

The Gillette community college district is 12 authorized to acquire or accept the transfer of ownership from the northern Wyoming community college district of six (6) 13 facilities totaling approximately two hundred twelve thousand 14 seven hundred ninety-eight (212,798) square feet consisting of 15 technical education center A, technical education center B, 16 pronghorn center, tanner village 4, high plains grill and 17 Gillette college agricultural complex. 18
