Subject: Acceptance of retrocession federal military installations.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act authorizes the Governor to accept in writing on behalf of the state full or partial retrocession of jurisdiction over any military reservations and lands previously ceded to the United States, including F.E. Warren Air Force Base, where such retrocession has been offered by the appropriate federal authority.
- This act provides that the Governor may accept retrocession of criminal jurisdiction, civil jurisdiction, juvenile jurisdiction or any combination thereof.
- This act provides that the Governor's written acceptance of retrocession becomes effective upon filing the acceptance in the Secretary of State's office.
