 41 hours, and meeting such other criteria as established by the
 42 eligible institution to ensure the student earns his degree or
 43 certificate in a timely manner. The student's hours of enrollment
 44 for purposes of this paragraph shall be the same number of hours

1 of enrollment used to determine the state's obligation to reimburse
2 the eligible institution for the student's scholarship under this
3 article. Satisfactory academic progress shall be determined
4 annually following the spring semester, but a student's
5 scholarship may be reinstated pursuant to W.S. 21-16-1304(f)(i) or
6 21-16-1305(d)(i) following any semester or summer school session.
7 For students enrolled in a program at a Wyoming community college
8 that requires on-the-job training and less than six (6) credit
9 hours per semester to receive a certificate, "satisfactory
10 academic progress" means completing all semester hours the student
11 is enrolled in each semester, meeting the hourly on-the-job
12 training requirements and meeting other criteria as established by
13 the Wyoming community college to ensure the student earns the
14 certificate in a timely manner;

19 (a) Any student who meets the criteria under W.S. 21-16-1303
20 is eligible to receive a scholarship to pursue a degree or
21 certificate as follows:

23 (i) With a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 2.50
24 and a score equal to or greater than the 2015-2016 national
25 percentile rank of forty-three (43) on a college entrance
26 examination administered throughout the United States and relied
27 upon by institutions of higher education to determine acceptance
28 of students for attendance, a Hathaway opportunity scholarship
29 for:

31 (C) For students enrolled in a program at a Wyoming
32 community college that requires on-the-job training and credit
33 hours to receive a certificate that are enrolled in less than six
34 (6) hours per semester, the amount provided under subparagraph (A)
35 of this paragraph times a fraction, the numerator of which is the
36 number of hours for which the student is enrolled and the
37 denominator is twelve (12).

39 (ii) With a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 3.0
40 and a score equal to or greater than the 2015-2016 national
41 percentile rank of fifty-six (56) on a college entrance examination
42 administered throughout the United States and relied upon by
43 institutions of higher education to determine acceptance of
44 students for attendance, a Hathaway performance scholarship for:

46 (C) For students enrolled in a program at a Wyoming
47 community college that requires on-the-job training and credit

1 hours to receive a certificate that are enrolled in less than six
2 (6) hours per semester, the amount provided under subparagraph (A)
3 of this paragraph times a fraction, the numerator of which is the
4 number of hours for which the student is enrolled and the
5 denominator is twelve (12).

7 (iii) With a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 3.5
8 and a score equal to or greater than the 2015-2016 national
9 percentile rank of seventy-nine (79) on an examination
10 administered throughout the United States and relied upon by
11 institutions of higher education to determine acceptance of
12 students for attendance, a Hathaway honor scholarship for:

14 (C) For students enrolled in a program at a Wyoming
15 community college that requires on-the-job training and credit
16 hours to receive a certificate that are enrolled in less than six
17 (6) hours per semester, the amount provided under subparagraph (A)
18 of this paragraph times a fraction, the numerator of which is the
19 number of hours for which the student is enrolled and the
20 denominator is twelve (12).

22 (c) To remain eligible for the scholarship under this
23 section, the student shall:

24
25 (i) Except as provided in W.S. 21-16-1303(f) and
26 subsection (h) of this section, make satisfactory academic
27 progress toward a certificate or degree. If a student fails to
28 make satisfactory academic progress or maintain the cumulative
29 grade point average required for continuation in the program as
30 provided in this subsection, the student shall become ineligible
31 for the scholarship in subsequent semesters unless granted an
32 exception for cause by the department or except as otherwise
33 provided in subsection (f) of this section. The department may
34 delegate to any eligible institution the department's authority to
35 grant an exception for cause, but shall only do so in accordance
36 with department rules establishing procedures and criteria for
37 granting an exception and any eligible institution acting pursuant
38 to such delegation shall grant exceptions only in accordance with
39 those rules;

41 **21-16-1305. Hathaway provisional opportunity scholarships.**

43 (a) Any student who meets the criteria under W.S. 21-16-1303
44 is eligible to receive a Hathaway provisional opportunity
45 scholarship to pursue a certificate or degree as follows:
46

1 (i) With a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 2.50
2 and either a score equal to or greater than the 2015-2016 national
3 percentile rank of thirty (30) on a college entrance examination
4 administered throughout the United States and relied upon by
5 institutions of higher education to determine acceptance of
6 students for attendance or a qualifying cumulative score on a
7 career-technical aptitude test as determined by the department, a
8 scholarship for:

10 (C) For students enrolled in a program at a Wyoming
11 community college that requires on-the-job training and credit
12 hours to receive a certificate that are enrolled in less than six
13 (6) hours per semester, the amount provided under subparagraph (A)
14 of this paragraph times a fraction, the numerator of which is the
15 number of hours for which the student is enrolled and the
